



Regional Masters Event - General entry guide and regulations

1. This event is part of the Scottish Squash Masters Tournament Circuit
2. A knock-out system with first match losers going into a Plate Competition, or a round robin will be used depending on the number of entries. Age groups may be combined if insufficient numbers.
3. The Championships will be played under the rules of the World Squash Federation (WSF) and the Scottish Squash and Racketball Code of Conduct and Fair Play Statement will apply.
4. All matches will be the best of 5 games using the traditional scoring system up to 9 points. All players should make themselves available for play 30mins prior to their match time. The match time is an approximate time, as all matches will run consecutively.
5. Drug testing may take place at this event in line with Scottish Squash and Racketball's Anti Doping Resolution.
6. Players will be required to mark and referee matches.
7. Video recording of some matches may take place at this event; photographs may also be taken for promotional purposes including publication on websites. By signing the entry form you indicate your acceptance of these conditions.
8. Players enter the event at their own risk. Scottish Squash and Racketball and the host venue do not accept responsibility for any injury arising from participating in the tournament..
9. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final.
10. In the event of a withdrawal prior to the closing date a full refund, less bank and administration fees, will be given.

In the event of a withdrawal after the closing date and before the draw date a 50% refund will be given less bank and administration fees.

In the event of a withdrawal on or after the day of the draw, no refunds will be given.
