Arrival/Travel In Edinburgh

Edinburgh International Airport (www.edinburghairport.com; 0844 481 8989)

Edinburgh International Airport is 8 miles (12 km) from Edinburgh City Centre. Buses to Edinburgh city centre stop on the terminal forecourt, outside the main entrance. Buses operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week, with a journey time of 25 minutes to Edinburgh (Waverley train station). Tickets can be bought from the airport information desks or on the bus itself.

There are separate taxi ranks for private airport taxis and for city "black cabs" outside the east (UK Arrivals) end of the terminal building.

Rail Travel (www.nationalrail.co.uk; 08457 48 49 50)

Edinburgh Waverley Station is at the east end of Princes Street (city centre) and Edinburgh Haymarket is at the West End. Onward travel to the Courtyard Marriot Edinburgh West Hotel/Oriam and Edinburgh Sports Club is via taxi or bus.

We have been made aware that Network Rail are carrying out vital engineering work near Edinburgh Haymarket train station between Friday 27th – Sunday 29th December 2019. This means services on several routes to and from Edinburgh will start and terminate before reaching the capital city.

If you are planning to travel to the Edinburgh area on these dates, please consider making alternative arrangements, particularly on Saturday 28th December. We strongly recommend familiarising yourself with Scot Rail/Network Rail's further information on the planned engineering work.

Tournament Hotel

The Championship hotel is detailed below and is situated on the Heriot-Watt University Edinburgh campus next to Oriam.

Tournament Draw, First Match Times and Results

First Round match times will be e-mailed out to players and available on the Scottish Squash website: www.scottishsquash.org.

Advertised times of matches should be regarded as a guide only. Matches will follow immediately after preceding matches wherever possible.

Competitors should ensure that they are present at least 1 hour prior to the advertised time of their match.

Squash Ball

The Dunlop Pro XX will be the official match squash ball.

Eye Protection

The use of approved eye protection is compulsory for under 19's at all times whilst on court.

Referees and Markers

Whilst we have qualified referees and markers attending the event, players will be expected to mark matches.

All winning players must referee the following match on their court. Failure to do so may result in disqualification from the tournament.

Changing Facilities

Changing facilities for men and women are available at the venue. Scottish Squash or the venues can not be held responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Catering & Refreshments

Hot food and snacks are available for purchase at both venues.

Lunch meal vouchers will be given out at the start of the tournament to those who have taken the accommodation packages. Meal vouchers are for use only at the venue where your draw takes place.

Meal Vouchers are non-transferable and must be used on the date shown on the voucher. No change will be given. Individuals are responsible for their own meal vouchers and they will not be replaced if lost.

The bistro in Oriam will be open from 08:30-14:30 each day.

Drug Testing


Drug testing may be carried out during the tournament. Testing will be carried out in accordance with the World Anti Doping Agency World Anti Doping Code
