Bridge of Allan is located two miles from Stirling City Centre and enjoys good road/rail links to all major towns particularly Glasgow and Edinburgh and is within easy driving distance of towns such as Falkirk, Grangemouth and Perth.

You would report to the Management Committee for day to day running of the club including operation of bar/catering facilities. In doing so you would also assist the Management Committee in promoting/marketing the club's facilities and social activities.

Responsibilities

- Managing the recruitment, training, wages and records of bar/ancillary staff ie training in First Aid/Food Hygiene.
- Running bar as licensee so ensuring compliance with licensing laws and stock keeping of food and drink.
- Keeping membership data base updated with new member inductions and sending membership renewal notices.
- Managing club website and online booking system.
- Liaising with any contractors and managing invoices.
- Liaising with groundsman/fitness instructor to ensure equipment is maintained.
- Liaise with and assist tennis, squash and social convenors in relation to tournaments and events.
- Liaise with representatives of Active Stirling, Scottish Squash and Tennis Scotland and support squash/tennis coaches.
- Preparing and attending Management Committee Meetings.
- Deal with verbal complaints.
- Ensure the daily cleaning and safety checks of club facilities are performed correctly.
- Act as Child Protection Officer, First Aider and Fire Officer.
- Play an active role in finding opportunities to increase revenue streams.

Previous experience in managing staff in a similar environment would be beneficial.
