

'Squash in Scotland' Membership Structure

1.0 Introduction

Following a comprehensive consultation process with all member clubs in 2021, Scottish Squash and its six Regional Associations (Central, East, Grampian, Highlands & Islands, Tayside & Fife and West) are pleased to be able to confirm details of the 'Squash in Scotland' membership structure.

The 'Squash in Scotland' structure combines the benefits of regional and national membership into a unified membership structure for all clubs and individuals across Scotland. This new membership structure will be introduced for the 2022-23 membership year, commencing 1st October 2022.

2.0 Membership Categories and Benefits

The 'Squash in Scotland' membership structure has both club membership packages (see 2.1.1 for full details & associated annual costs) and individual membership packages (see 2.1.2 for full details & associated annual costs).

2.1.1 Club Membership Categories

Clubs will have the opportunity to join the 'Squash in Scotland' structure on the following basis:

- a registration and payment process will be managed annually by Scottish Squash, with a pre-season renewal window open in September and October of each year;
- the process will invite the club to select one of the national club membership categories as listed in table 1 (with the associated benefits outlined in table 2);
- where a club's respective region has opted in (full details tbc), the process will amalgamate any regional club membership fee (as outlined in table 1) with any national club membership fee; and
- on completion of the process, and if relevant, an invoice will be issued to the club.

As a result of the new club membership categories and fees, clubs can expect to pay a reduced annual rate. It will be at the discretion of each individual club as to whether they opt to pass on any saving to their members, possibly in the form of a reduced annual club membership fee. This allows the opportunity for increased funds at a club level, should a club opt not to pass on this saving.

The 'Squash in Scotland' membership structure also provides clubs with the opportunity to bulk register and/or pay for their individual members' fees (see 2.1.2 for full details & associated annual costs) – effectively in a similar way to how fees were collected under the previous structure. Clubs should contact info@scottishsquash.org in the first instance and ahead of a new membership year commencing.

**Non-constituted clubs (i.e. a group of individuals playing from a public facility) will not be required to pay a national club membership fee as it is recognised that the benefits are negligible in such circumstances. In this case, one of the individual members should contact info@scottishsquash.org ahead of the membership year commencing.

2.1.3 Individual Membership Categories

Individuals will have the opportunity to join the 'Squash in Scotland' structure on the following basis:

- the registration and payment process will be managed via [SportyHQ](#), with individuals able to join or renew at any point in the year;
- an individual should search for the '[Squash in Scotland](#)' profile on SportyHQ, select 'Join Today' or 'Renew Membership' and follow the registration process; and
- the process will ask the individual to join/renew on one of the individual membership categories, of which the categories and costs are detailed in table 3 & the associated benefits in table 4.

Table 3 gives an overview of the individual membership categories and associated costs:

Supporter	£0	Any individual who would like to receive e-newsletters and communications regarding squash in Scotland

Player	£15	Any player who plays in a regional multi-club league, takes part in Scottish Squash sanctioned competitions and/or is a member of a Scottish Squash run programme or initiative.
Coach Licence	£15*	Any coach operating within Scotland who would like to ensure they are working under the correct governance.
Referee Registration	£0	Any referee looking to be recognised as an official Scottish Squash Referee and therefore gaining the opportunity to referee at platinum competitions.

*Coach Licence includes access to all Player benefits at no additional cost.
