

# Scottish Squash Limited (SSL) Board – May 2023

Regional Committee / Director update following SSL Board Meeting 15<sup>th</sup> May 2023

#### **Purpose**

This is a note to the Board Directors and for sharing with key contacts / Regional Committee members aimed at keeping the squash community in Scotland up to date with key issues being discussed at National level. It is meant to be both 'standalone' and a 'prompt' to SSL Board members to provide a briefing for the Regional Committees and mentions those issues which are considered disclosable (e.g., excludes for example discipline, selection appeals).

#### Introductions

The Chair, Paul Macari welcomed everyone to the meeting and reserved a special congratulations for the Women's National Team who were recently promoted back to division 1 of the European Team Championships following their success in winning division 2 in April.

### <u>Finance</u>

It was confirmed that the draft year end accounts for 2022-23 had come in on budget with a breakeven position likely to be confirmed following an independent examination. Such a position would ensure that the company reserves remain comfortably within the reserves policy range.

Budgets have been prepared for the new 2023-24 financial year and confirmation of the new **sport**scotland investment for 2023-27 had been received. The governing body has secured a small uplift to specifically support the development of the player pathway within the <u>refreshed 2023-27 strategic plan</u>. The continued support from **sport**scotland was noted as was the ongoing support from Springfield Properties a the wider family of sponsors.

## Commercial

The Commercial Working Group have finalised a new commercial structure to support the growth of squash in Scotland. There are various partnership opportunities aligned to three key strands: elite performance; events; and community development. The major events strand and particularly the forthcoming 2023 Springfield Scottish Squash Open (20<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> September at Inverness Tennis & Squash Club) provides an immediate opportunity to engage potential new sponsors and re-engage sponsors from the 2022 event.









## **Risk and Compliance Sub Committee**

Developing a more robust succession plan for the recruitment of key Board roles remains a priority. Growing the new membership package, its benefits offer and ultimately the overall income to invest back into the sport continues to be a key focus, and the Membership Working Group has been reestablished to support this.

## **Strategy** (inc. Clubs, Competitions, Coaching & Players)

A vacancy remains as Equality Champion on the Board. A revised Equality Action Plan, to align to the 2023-27 strategic cycle, is being developed and the external diversity and inclusion working group is being re-established. <u>Applications are now being welcomed from individuals with expertise and experience in equality, diversity and inclusion to join the external working group.</u>

<u>Following a fundraising campaign led by the group of players and parents</u>, Scotland will send a women's team (for the first time since 2005) and additional male and female players to the individual World Championships in Australia in July.

Work continues on the development of the competition calendar for season 2023-24 and regions and clubs should stay posted for details of platinum host venues and gold sanctioned competition applications.

A project is underway to transition the referee workforce to the World Squash Officiating scheme.
