- Organise PPP U15/17 Development Squad sessions with support from the Pathway Manager & Coach.
- Plan and deliver PPP U15/17 Development Squad squash sessions.
- Provide group feedback after every squad session.
- Report back to the Pathway Manager & Coach after each squad.
- Provide individual in depth feedback using the player profile to each player twice a season.
- Be the point of contact with parents and key stakeholders where needed.
- Work in partnership with personal, club and regional coaches to develop the players.
- Follow coaching principles and philosophy of SSL Performance Pathway Team.
- Build an environment to encourage holistic Long Term Player Development of young players in Scotland.
