The club has 7 courts, although Court 5 is reserved for members of ASRC. Players are requested not to use Court 5 for practice without permission. The club will be open from 12:00 on Friday.

Breakfast is available Sat & Sun from Café Connect opposite the Spires, with a discounted rate available for players. The café is open from 08:00, with hot food available from 08:30. Please note breakfast is not included for those on packages.

Saturday Evening Banquet

This will be held at Aberdeen Squash & Racketball Club on the Saturday evening for pre-booked players, guests and event officials.

- The bar and lounge will close from approximately 17:00 – 18:30 to allow for the space to be set up for the banquet.
- Players and guests are requested to return to the club from 18:30 onwards. Entry to the banquet will be subject to guest list.
- Prize-giving will take place promptly at 19:30 followed by dinner. We request you to take your seats in time for prize-giving so as not to delay the catering team.
- The meal will be followed by music in the lounge. Please note the caterers will remove their furniture after the dinner and rearrange the room. This will be done as efficiently as possible to minimise disruption; thank you for your cooperation.

Captains' Meeting

There will be a Captains' meeting at 16:00 on Friday, please meet in the lounge. Squad orders must be set at this stage, and a team for the first round of fixtures must be submitted. Team submissions can be submitted to the TD via WhatsApp at least 30 mins prior to the match.

Practice Courts

Courts 1, 2, 3, 4, 6 & 7 are available from 14:30 on Friday for open practice. Please note Court 5 is reserved for members only at all times of the weekend.

Playing Order

The playing order is 5, 3, 1, 4, 2. Play is continuous. Players are requested to be ready to go on court immediately following the previous match.

Definitions

- Teams are players nominated to play in a specific tie.
- Ties are between opposing teams.
- Matches are between individual players.

Scoring

- PAR 11 scoring; must win by 2 clear points at 10-10. Best of 5 games.
- One score point is awarded for each game won in a match.
- The winner of the tie is the team with the most points after all matches are played.
- A bonus of 5 points is awarded to the team that wins the tie.
 - In the case of the number of points being equal, the winner of the tie will be the team with the highest number of match wins.

Team Finishing Positions

To decide team positions in the standings, the results will be taken in the following order:

- a) highest number of match wins.
- b) highest number of points for.
- c) lowest number of points against.
- d) the result of the match between the two teams who are tied.
 - If three or more teams are tied, the winner will be decided in the following order:
 - The team that won the most ties.
 - The team with the highest difference between games won and lost.
 - The team with the highest difference between points won and lost.

Score Cards

- The score cards with the team for the next tie must be filled out and handed to the tournament desk 30 mins prior to start time.
- The score card will then be passed from the tournament desk to the referee in charge of that fixture.
- Once the fixture has been completed, the referee will hand in the completed score card to the tournament desk.
