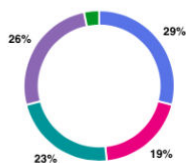

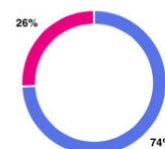
1. Which event in the Masters Home Internationals 2026 did you compete in?

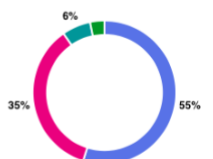
5. Did you purchase an accommodation package through the organisers?

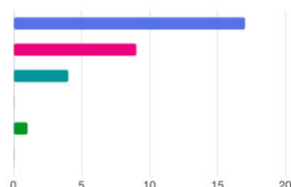
2. How would you rate your overall experience being part of the Masters Home Internationals in 2026?

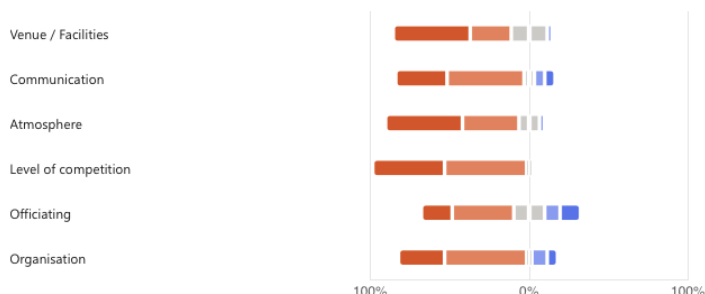
3. How would you rate communications from Scottish Squash relative to your selection and the event you competed in?

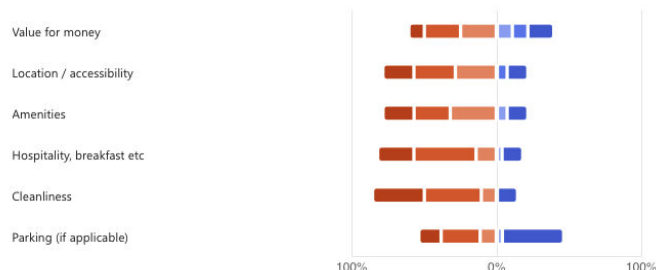
4. How was your experience of the squash competition?

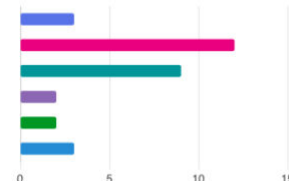
6. If yes, how would you rate the accommodation offering?

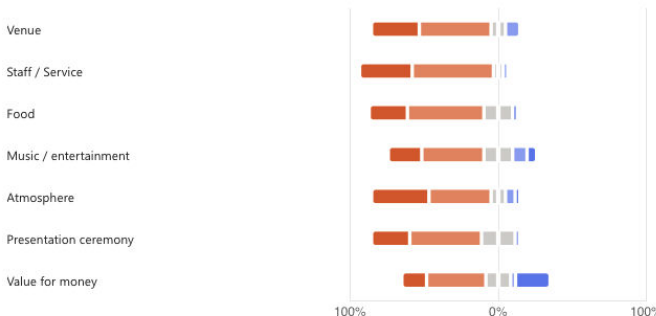
7. How would you rate the online coverage of the event?

Additional Feedback Information

Player feedback on the 2026 Home Internationals was overall positive, although a number of participants highlighted areas where improvements could be made. Players enjoyed the team camaraderie, the supportive environments, and the tough level of competition, with several reflecting on a successful year for Scottish teams. Positive remarks generally centred around organisational delivery and event atmosphere. Areas of focus for 2027:

- **Cost and value for money**, with a focus on clear pricing and transparent food package inclusions and charges.
- **Catering and bar provision**, including quality, value, choice and dietary requirements.
- **Referee availability**, ensuring appropriate officiating provision across events.
- **Scheduling and event format**; exploring ways to improve consistency and structure.
- **Media coverage and entertainment**, enhancing the overall event experience and engagement.
